3. Remit of the reference group

- 3.1 The purpose of the Joint Member Reference Group for Audit, Best Value and Community Services Scrutiny Committee and Children's Services Scrutiny Committee is to take an overview of:
- (1) Powers, responsibilities and roles of the local authority in relation to schools especially where the consequences of failure may impact upon the local authority.
- (2) How to achieve effective risk management by schools in matters such as:
 - Financial management
 - Staff appointments and personnel
 - · Property management.
- (3) How the local authority can influence school governors to ensure appropriate decision making by governors with particular reference to the selection, training and role of local authority governors.
