1. Background Information

1.1 The Position Statement is used by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) to assess an authority's progress in meeting the vision for libraries expressed in the 'Framework for The Future' and progress against the Public Library Standards.

1.2 The Position Statement for the Library and Information Services demonstrates significant progress towards meeting the Public Library Standards. At 31 March 2004, Library and Information Services met 20 from a possible 26 standards, an increase of six since March 2003. The Statement also demonstrates considerable commitment to the vision for libraries as expressed by the DCMS in terms of the main themes:

Section 1: Books, Reading and Learning Section 2: Digital Citizenship Section 3: Community and Civic Values Section 4: Building Capacity to Deliver Transformation

1.3 The draft will be revised and completed during September, and will be considered by the Lead Member for Children and Young People; and Libraries at the Individual Decision Making Meeting on 17 September.
