Purpose of report:	To provide the scrutiny committee with an end of year summary of performance against the 2005/06 Council Plan

RECOMMENDATION

The scrutiny committee is recommended to:

- 1. note the achievements during 2005/06 and the end of year performance results;
- 2. highlight those performance results which are of particular concern and ensure monitoring of these are timetabled into the committee's forward programme; and
- 3. establish a scrutiny review board to investigate in detail a number of performance indicators relating to educational attainment and report back to the next committee with its findings and recommendations.

1.0 Financial implications

1.1 There are no financial implications directly associated with this report.

2.0 Notable achievements

- 2.1 The committee will wish to note the selection of achievements at the end of 2005/06:
 - Better placement choice and stability for looked after children has been achieved through increases in all types of foster care including an increased pool of black and minority ethnic carers and specialist foster carers for disabled children. This year 30 foster carers were approved, 34 adopters were recruited and 36 children were matched to approved permanence foster carers in 2005/06 (against the target of 15);
 - Increased the number of schools with the silver Healthy School Scheme award from a third to just over half of all schools in East Sussex;
 - increased the percentage of schools with a teacher responsible for child protection, who has been trained within the last two years, from 83% to 98%;

- In 2005, children in East Sussex achieved above the national average in all three elements of personal, social and emotional development area of learning in the foundation stage profile;
- Increased the number of youth offenders with mental health needs who access Child and Adolescent Mental Health services promptly (within 15 working days of assessment) from 75% to 89%;
- Provided access to a Children's Centre for nearly 3000 children in the County;

3.0 Performance against Key Service Targets

- 3.1 Appendix 1 provides a summary of performance measures which have been scored red for 2005/06. The table also provides information on whether the measure has performed better or worse than in 2004/05.
- 3.2 The committee may wish to highlight those performance results which are of particular concern and ensure monitoring of these are timetabled into the committee's forward programme.

4.0 Establishment of a review board

- 4.1 Appendix 2 lists those BVPIs which relate to educational attainment and are primarily monitored by the Education Standards Panel as part of the wider attainment analysis.
- 4.2 Due to the monitoring work carried out by the Education Standards Panel the scrutiny committee does not usually look at these BVPIs in particular detail. However, due to the high number of reds at Q4 it is suggested that a scrutiny review board is set up to concentrate on these particular nine BVPIs.
- 4.3 The review board will allow members an opportunity to increase their knowledge around attainment indicators, consider how East Sussex fits within a national context and understand the way in which value added data is able to tailor performance information to reflect the makeup of pupils within East Sussex.
