1. Background

1.1 The decision made by Cabinet on 5 June 2007 in relation to assistance with transport for pupils attending denominational schools was called in by Tony Campbell, Jeremy Taylor and Sarah Maynard (co-opted members of the Children's Services Scrutiny Committee). 1.2 As Monitoring Officer I agreed to this call in on 14 June on the basis that it is confined only to points 3, 5 and 6. My reasons for this decision are outlined at Appendix B.

1.4 A report regarding a change of policy in respect of assistance with transport for children attending denominational transport was presented to Cabinet on 30 January 2007 and 5 June 2007 (these reports are attached at Appendix D & E).
