Title of Report: Looked After Children (LAC) Statistics

Purpose of Report: To update the Panel on changes in the last quarter

Recommendations: The Corporate Parenting Panel is recommended to note the contents

## 1. Financial Appraisal

1.1 Services for LAC are funded from the Children's Services base budget and supported with transformation money agreed within the Thrive budget.

## 2. Supporting information

- 2.1 The most recent LAC statistics are attached as Appendix 1.
- 2.2 Between the end of September and the end of December 2012, the upward trend in the overall number of LAC appears to have been reversed and LAC numbers have stabilised with 1 less child overall at the end of the quarter.
- 2.3 At the end of the quarter, the total number of children in foster care has increased by 1, with the same number of placements with in house foster carers and 9 fewer agency foster care placements. This obviously represents a significant financial saving. There has also been an increase of 5 children with kinship carers. There were 3 parent and baby placements, a rise of 2 placements.
- 2.4 The number of children placed with prospective adopters has fallen by 3. Activity rates are obviously closely allied to individual care planning for children.
- 2.5 The number of children subject to a Care Order placed at home with their parents has risen by 3 at the end of the quarter. These placements are always monitored rigorously in order to mitigate any risk factors and agreement to the placement is given at a senior level.
- 2.6 The number of children subject to Residence Orders has risen by 13, with 22 additional children becoming subject to Special Guardianship Orders.
- 2.7 At the end of December there were 3 young people resident at The Bungalow and 3 at Acorns
- 2.8 At the end of the quarter 1 East Sussex child was subject to a Secure Order and was resident at Lansdowne.
- 2.9 Numbers of young people placed in bed and breakfast accommodation have fallen again in the past quarter. And at the end of December there were 3 Further work continues with the aim of increasing accommodation options for careleavers

## 3. Conclusion

3.1 LAC numbers are closely monitored by the management team and also within the overall Thrive programme. We are beginning to see overall LAC numbers stabilising. However this is offset by an ongoing rise in children subject to both Residence Orders and to Special Guardianship Orders. There will be ongoing financial expenditure in respect of that group of children, albeit at a lower level than if the children were to enter or remain in the care system. It is also the case that although this offers very positive permanent outcomes for some individual children it effectively takes some foster carers 'off the books' in terms of offering other placements.
