- Prevention

- Transfer of care
- Ongoing care

Provided through

- A specialist hyper acute stroke unit
- An acute stroke unit
- A rehabilitation unit
- Early supported discharge
- Community stroke support

Key areas that the accelerated stroke programme identified are

- AF (Atrial Fibrilation) detection and treatment
- Direct admission to a stroke unit
- Scanning in a timely manner
- Timely and effective management of TIA (Transient Ischaemic Attack)
- Psychological support
- Early Supported discharge

Other services which are required are

- Information provision
- Carers support
- Stroke reviews

Looking at the proposals that are currently being consulted on we would also expect that this service was designed to accommodate the number of people who are experiencing a stroke in the area.
