


Site 1 - Little Common School, Hillborough Close Bexhill






Site 3 - Chantry Community Primary School, Barrack Road and Crowmere Avenue, Bexhill











Site 13 - Buckhurst Road, Upper Sea Road and Garden Close North Zone Bexhill



Site 14 - Reginald Road, Leopold Road and Windsor Road North Zone Bexhill






Site 1 - Old Manor Close East Zone Bexhill – Revised proposal








Site 1 – Lower Lake, Battle













PLAN SHOWING BLOCK PLAN OF SITE
