











PROPOSED SITE LAYOUT




PROPOSED PLAN OF THE FOOTPRINT OF THE NEW BUILDING ADJACENT TO THE EXISTING CRAFT BLOCK






BLOCK C - PROPOSED SOUTH ELEVATION




BLOCK C - PROPOSED EAST ELEVATION


NEW BUILDING GROUND FLOOR GENERAL ARRANGEMENT PLAN
