Notice under The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

On 20 October 2020 the County Council intends to hold a meeting of the Lead Member for Resources which will be Part exempt.

The reason for this is Local Government Act 1972 as amended, Schedule 12A paragraph 3.

Under the requirements of Regulation 5(2) of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 the Council is required to give 28 days notice of a private meeting identified within the scope of these Regulations. The following items are considered urgent:

The item (Warwick House, Seaford - proposed leasing of vacant accommodation to Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust) is considered urgent and cannot be deferred as the lease is due to start in November.

The item (Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust tenancy at Sackville House, Lewes) is considered urgent and cannot be deferred as the lease is due to start in November.

The item (NHS - East Sussex Clinical Commissioning Group's tenancy at Sackville House, Lewes) is considered urgent and cannot be deferred as the lease is due to start in November.

For this reason compliance is considered impracticable, and an exception to Regulation 5(2) is therefore sought under Regulation 5(6) of the above Regulations.
