<p>No: 1 Where are the cars going to go</p> <p>No: 2 I live with there are 12 flats with only 5 parking spaces</p> <p>No: 3 The local shop is a very busy shop & people park in the lay by to go to the shop</p> <p>No: 4 If they can't park in the lay by, they will park outside the shop, which is very dangerous because it is a very busy road</p> <p>No: 5 They are taking some of the busses off, there is not one on a Saturday, when they do run they are not very busy, so they don't need to stop in the lay by very much</p> <p>No: 6 It is a very busy shop, I sometimes have to wait to get out, it is very dangerous not only for cars and lorries, but people coming out or going into the shop</p>	<p>Discussions regarding the position of the BSC were discussed at length with our Passenger Transport Team & Plumpton Parish Council (PPC) & has been proposed at a minimum length to still retain some parking in the lay by</p> <p>Comments have been noted regarding lack of parking spaces for those that live at 'The Riddens', However it is not the responsibility of East Sussex County Council to provide on street parking for residents</p> <p>Parking for the local shop in Station Road has been previously discussed at length with PPC, & they have advised the they still wish to progress with the BSC</p> <p>Parking outside the shop has been an ongoing issue. Various discussions have been made with PPC & they do not wish to see parking restrictions here</p> <p>Concerns have been noted that the bus service no longer runs on a Saturday. Prior to consultation, we liaised with our Passenger Transport team to ascertain what times the buses run. Our proposals are for the BSC to be in force between Monday – Friday 7am – 7pm, so parking in the lay by outside of these hours & all day Saturday & Sunday will be permitted</p> <p>Please see above comments in No: 4</p>	<p>To implement the BSC as advertised</p>

<p>No: 8 I live on the old peoples flats & we have nurses come every day to the people, how are they going to get on</p>	<p>Comments have been noted regarding nurses not being able to park when visiting flats. Please see previous comments from No: 2. It is suggested that alternative arrangements would need to be considered for visits</p>
