 - Reason: To safeguard the historic fabric and architectural character and appearance of this listed building.
- 4. The County Council's Head of Planning and Environment shall be notified of any additional works identified as being necessary during the course of solely implementing the development hereby approved. Any variation to the approved details shall be submitted for

agreement in writing by the Head of Planning and Environment prior to the works being implemented. The works shall then be carried out in accordance with the approved details.
