EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHWAY ACT 1980 – SECTIONS 65 and 66 Shared footway/cycleway on Dordrecht Way, Hastings

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 65 (1), 65 (2), and 66 of the Highway Act 1980 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby propose the conversion of an existing footway to that of a shared footway/cycleway between 2 and 3 meters in width along:

Dordrecht Way (Western Side) – from a point 4 metres south of its junction with St Helens Road south for a distance of 10 metres

Dordrecht Way (Eastern Side) - from a point 2.5 metres south of its junction with St Helens Road south for a distance of 12.5 metres.

The above is proposed to provide a safe, continuous, footway / cycleway across Dordrecht Way as a part of the proposed cycle route through Alexandra Park, which will provide benefits to the wider community and improve the environment.
