Provide a description of your proposal	To introduce more consistent charges for parking and permits across our Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE) areas. To do this, charges in Rother District need to be increased, and permit charges adjusted to be based on vehicle emission levels. These changes to charges took place in Eastbourne Borough and Hastings Borough in July 2020 to bring the charges in line with those in Lewes District. Rother charges were excluded at the time because we were going through the process of implementing CPE in the district, which did not go live until September 2020. Management of on street parking helps to support some of the aims of the Local Transport Plan. Parking charges are set at a level to encourage the use of lower polluting vehicles and using more sustainable means of transport where possible. For those that need to use a private vehicle, long term parking is encouraged in car parks with on street parking being used for short stay parking to support business and trade. Long term on street parking is available for residents within the parking scheme, with permits priced according to vehicle emissions.
