ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (A259 Newhaven Road and Buckle Bypass, Seaford) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 201*

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 mph on those lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (A259 Newhaven Road and Buckle Bypass, Seaford) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 201*" and shall come into operation on 201*.

FIRST SCHEDULE 50 mph Speed Limit

A259 Newhaven Road and Buckle Bypass

from a point 398 metres north-west of its junction with Bishopstone Road, in a south-easterly direction to a point 148 metres north-west of its junction with Beacon Road.
