## EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## The East Sussex (Old Malling Area, Lewes)(20 mph Speed Limit) Order 201\*

East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2), 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act propose to make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the \* day of \* 201\* and may be cited as "East Sussex County Council (Old Malling Area, Lewes) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 201\*" hereinafter called "this Order".
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
