The programme is led by the County Council, the Eastbourne Hailsham and Seaford Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and the Hastings and Rother CCG. Since the High Weald Lewes Havens CCG's decision to develop a separate programme, Connecting 4 You, it has been agreed that the Board will continue to scrutinise this programme, as well as ESBT.

2.2 The Scrutiny Board is made up of representatives from this Committee, the Audit, Best Value and Community Services Scrutiny Committee and the Adult Social Care and Community Safety Scrutiny Committee. The Children's Services Scrutiny Committee has 3 places on the Board. One of these places is currently held by Councillor Michael Ensor, who is now no longer a member of this committee. It is therefore recommended that along with Councillors Field and Shing as its other representatives, the Committee nominate a new Member to join the ESBT Scrutiny Board.
