	LW agreed there had been a downturn and explained that there is an issue with secondary schools not meeting statutory legislation i.e. not all schools are compliant, but LW did point out that East Sussex are above the national picture with GCSE results.	
	Becky Gough confirmed that RE is one of the low priority GCSE's.	
	Cllr Stogdon referred to the term 'British Values' in the Scrutiny report and asked if the Scrutiny Committee will understand the context of British Values. LW agreed to add a footnote to the report as clarification.
