ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**The East Sussex (Lewes District) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2004 Amendment Order 2005 No. 1 (Amendment Order No.)\*(Seaford) 201\***

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to amend the above named Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, which would introduce stopping and waiting restrictions in the following lengths of road:-

**No Waiting 8.30am-9.30am and 2.30pm-3.30pm Monday to Friday**

**Seaford**

**Barn Rise**

north east side from its junction with Lexden Drive north-eastwards for a distance of 32 metres  
south- east side from a point 4 metres southwest of the property boundary of Nos.75 and 77 Barn Rise south-westwards to its junction with Barn Rise

**Jubilee Gardens**

north-west side from its junction with Lexden Drive south-westwards for a distance of 12 metres  
south-east side from its junction with Lexden Drive south-westwards for a distance of 13 metres

**Lexden Drive**

north-east side from its junction with Barn Rise south-eastwards for a distance of 54 metres.  
from a point 4 metres southeast of the property boundary of Nos.39 and 41 Lexden Drive south-eastwards to its junction with Barn Rise  
south-west side from its junction with Jubilee Gardens south-eastwards for a distance of 45 metres  
from its junction with Jubilee Gardens north-westwards for a distance of 16 metres

**Pitt Drive**

both sides from the junction with Lexden Drive for its entire length.

**No Stopping on School Keep Clear markings 8.00am-9.30am and 2.45pm-4.00pm Monday to Friday (except August)**

**Seaford**

**Lexden Road**

south-west side from a point opposite a point 2 metres north-west of the boundary of Nos.80 and 82 Lexden Road north-westwards for a distance of 33 metres.
