**The East Sussex (Borough of Hastings) (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2013
(Harrow Lane) Amendment Order 202* No.***

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, which will introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in the following length of road:

No Waiting At Any Time in the following roads in St Leonards on Sea
Harrow Lane - north-west side - from the southwestern boundary of 207 Harrow Lane for 97.5 metres north-eastwards then northwards.
